

**CITY OF LANSING**  
**NON-DOMESTIC SEWER DISCHARGE PERMIT**  
**SIGNIFICANT INDUSTRIAL USER**

In accordance with certain provisions of the Federal Water Pollution Control Act, as amended (33 U.S.C. 1251 et seq; the "Act"), the Michigan Water Resources Act (Act 245, Public Acts of 1929, as amended; the "Michigan Act"), and the Industrial Waste and Pretreatment Ordinance of the City of Lansing (Chapter 1046 of the City Code, as amended; the "Ordinance"),

**Schultz, Inc.**

is authorized to discharge wastewater from the facility located at:

**750 Lake Lansing Road Lansing, MI 48906**

subject to the effluent limitations/monitoring requirements specified in Part I Section A.1, through the outfalls and into the sanitary sewer identified in Part I Section A.2, and in accordance with other conditions set forth in Parts I and II hereof. Compliance with this permit does not relieve the permittee of its obligation to comply with any or all applicable pretreatment laws, regulations, standards or requirements under City, State, and Federal laws, including any such laws, regulations, standards, requirements, or laws that may become effective during the term of this permit and which shall apply to the permittee subsequent to modification of this permit and a reasonable period to achieve compliance.

Failure to meet the provisions of this permit, the Ordinance, or any order of the City, may constitute noncompliance and subject the permittee to appropriate enforcement action, including legal action and termination of service.

This permit, No. C-800-I-080119, is based on the permittee's application received May 17, 2016. This permit is **effective immediately** and shall **expire on August 1, 2019**.

If the permittee wishes to continue to discharge after the expiration date of this permit, a renewal application must be filed with the City a minimum of ninety (90) days prior to the expiration date in accordance with the requirements of Chapter 1046.11 of the Ordinance. Approval or denial of this application will be per Ordinance provisions. The City may establish appropriate fees for reimbursement of costs to administer this permit and the associated Industrial Pretreatment Program.
